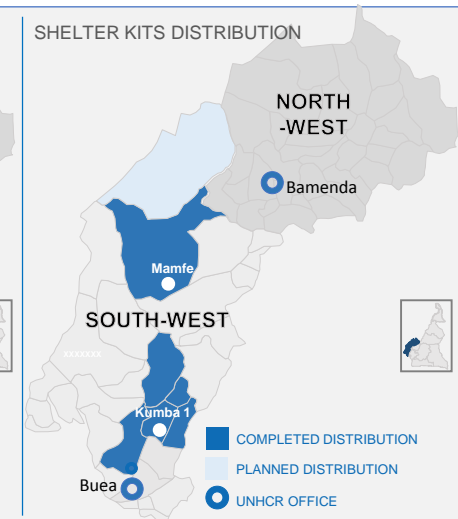
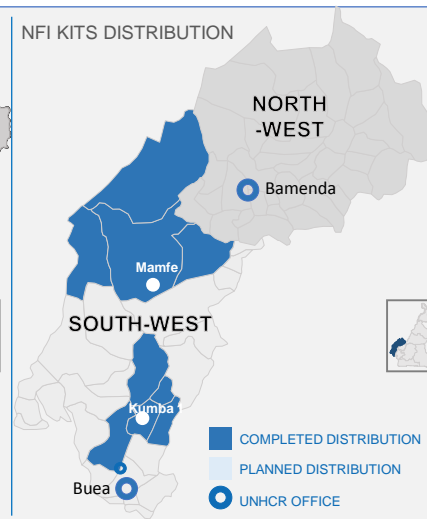
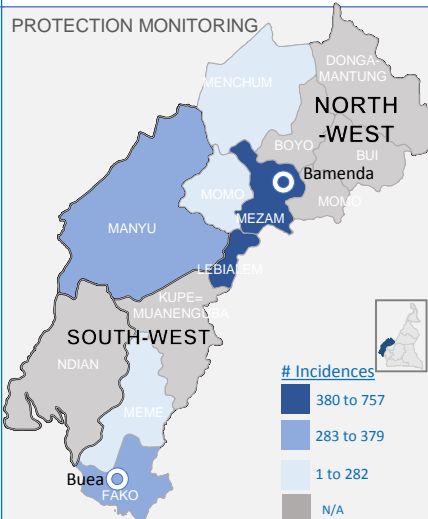


IDPs BY REGION

- Referral pathway strategy document for child protection in development.

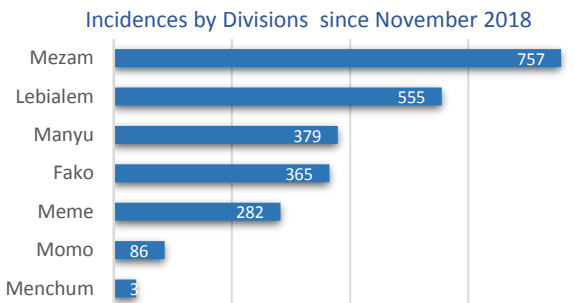
SHELTER/NFI CLUSTER

- Meets every 2 weeks
- Strategy and Terms of Reference finalized
- Standard NFI kits decided amongst partners and in agreement with WASH cluster coordinator
- Draft vulnerability criteria document available
- IM support to partners available

UPCOMING ACTIVITIES

- Protection Cluster and Shelter Cluster Meeting planned for 27 March in Bamenda
- Information Management support training in collaboration with at least 3 clusters (Shelter/NFI, WASH & Food Security) on 5W to take place in Bamenda

PROTECTION

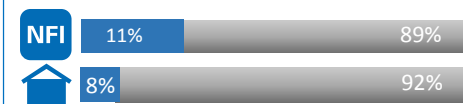


- Protection interventions for SGBV, child protection and community mobilization and empowerment.
- Protection monitoring with INTERSOS (30 protection monitors, supported by social workers)
- More than **2462** incidences recorded
- 172** Villages burnt, with **67** severely damaged.

SHELTER/NFI

- 6,000** kits distributed to a total of **34,986** persons.
- 4000** Shelter kits transported to Kumba and Mamfe (Meme and Manyu division)
- 2800** Shelter kits already distributed in localities in Meme
- 800** Shelter kits distributed to **4160** persons in localities in Manyu.
- 400** Shelter Kits Planned for distribution in Manyu
