

- 4. The broadly earmarked contributions listed are those which can potentially be used for South Sudan due to their earmarking to a related situation or theme, or to the region or sub-region. The total amount of the contributions is shown for donors who have contributed \$2 million and more.
- 5. The total amount of unearmarked contributions is shown for donors who have contributed \$10 million and more.
