

The 3RP 2017-18 is a nationally-led process, incorporating in full the Lebanon Crisis Response Plan (LCRP) and Jordan Response Plan (JRP) and the Turkey. Irag and Egypt country chapters that have been developed with the full involvement of the respective governments.

Regionally, more than 240 Partners are working through the 2017-2018 3RP framework, either appealing directly for funding, as partners of appealing agencies, or as part of the broader platform of policy, advocacy and delivery. Partners include government authorities in host countries, United Nations agencies, non-government organizations, donor governments, the private sector, charities and foundations.

3RP partners strive to address the needs of the most vulnerable through effective humanitarian and resilience-based interventions, while building a more sustainable response. Efficiencies include the use of biometrics for refugee registration, increased use of cash-based interventions for food and other basic needs assistance, integrated education, protection and youth services, and a focus on service delivery through local and municipal systems to reduce duplication and build national capacities.
