

Key Achievements in 2018



12,697 medical consultations (35,091 in 2017)



23,406 IDPs and refugees received non-food items (113,605 in 2017)



2,674 IDP and refugee households received cash assistance (3,314 in 2017)



15,021 individuals registered since 2016 (6,860 in 2018)



2,674 rescue kits and 336 medical consultations provided at disembarkation points (5,327 and 2,956 in 2017)



420 monitoring visits to detention centres (1,080 in 2017)



983 detained refugees/asylum-seekers released (1,428 in 2017)



1,807 refugees and asylum-seekers reached with solutions since Sept 2017: 465 resettlement submissions to third countries and 1,342 individuals evacuated from Libya (1,020 to Niger, 312 to Italy and 10 to Romania)
