

Mbera camp

-  **5,298** Students enrolled in primary school
-  **365** Students enrolled in secondary school
-  **3,000** Shelter kits distributed (end Dec 2018 - early 2019)
-  **47** Refugees attending university thanks to DAFI scholarships
-  **147** Refugees and host community members enrolled in UNHCR/ILO on-the-job training
-  **100%** Malian refugees with specific needs assisted

Urban areas

-  **401** Urban refugee children enrolled in primary and secondary education
-  **43** university scholarships granted to urban refugees
-  **114** Officials trained in international refugee law in 2019
-  **126** Microcredit projects supported
- **100%** Urban refugees have access to primary and secondary healthcare
