



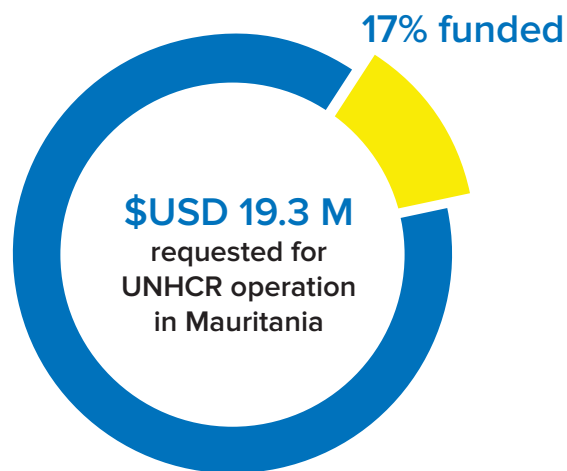

Urban areas

-  **477** Urban refugee children enrolled in primary and secondary education

-  **114** Officials trained in international refugee law in 2019

Achievements and Challenges

Mbera camp

-  **5,108** Students enrolled in primary school
-  **365** Students enrolled in secondary school
-  **3,000** shelter kits distributed (end Dec 2018 - early 2019)
-  **80** Refugees attending university with scholarships
-  **147** refugees and host community members enrolled in UNHCR/ILO on-the-job training
-  **100%** Of Malian refugees with specific needs assisted
-  **1** registration point enhanced in Fassala (Malian border)
