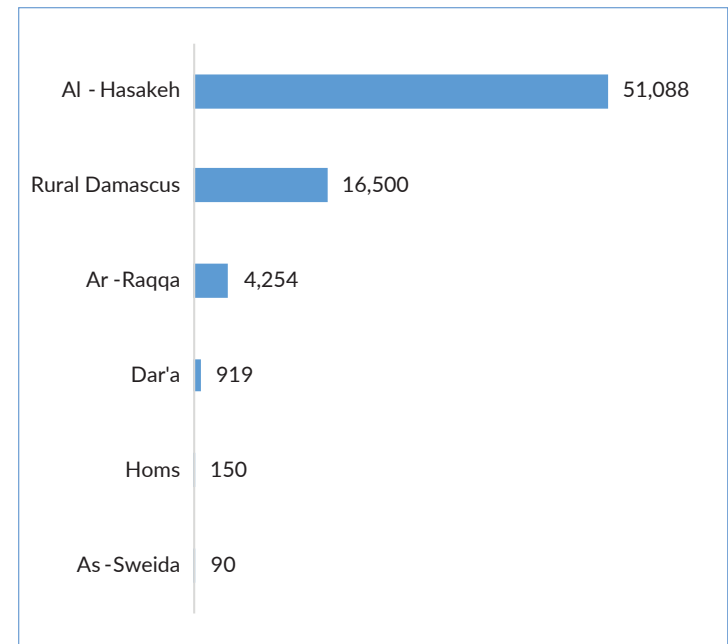
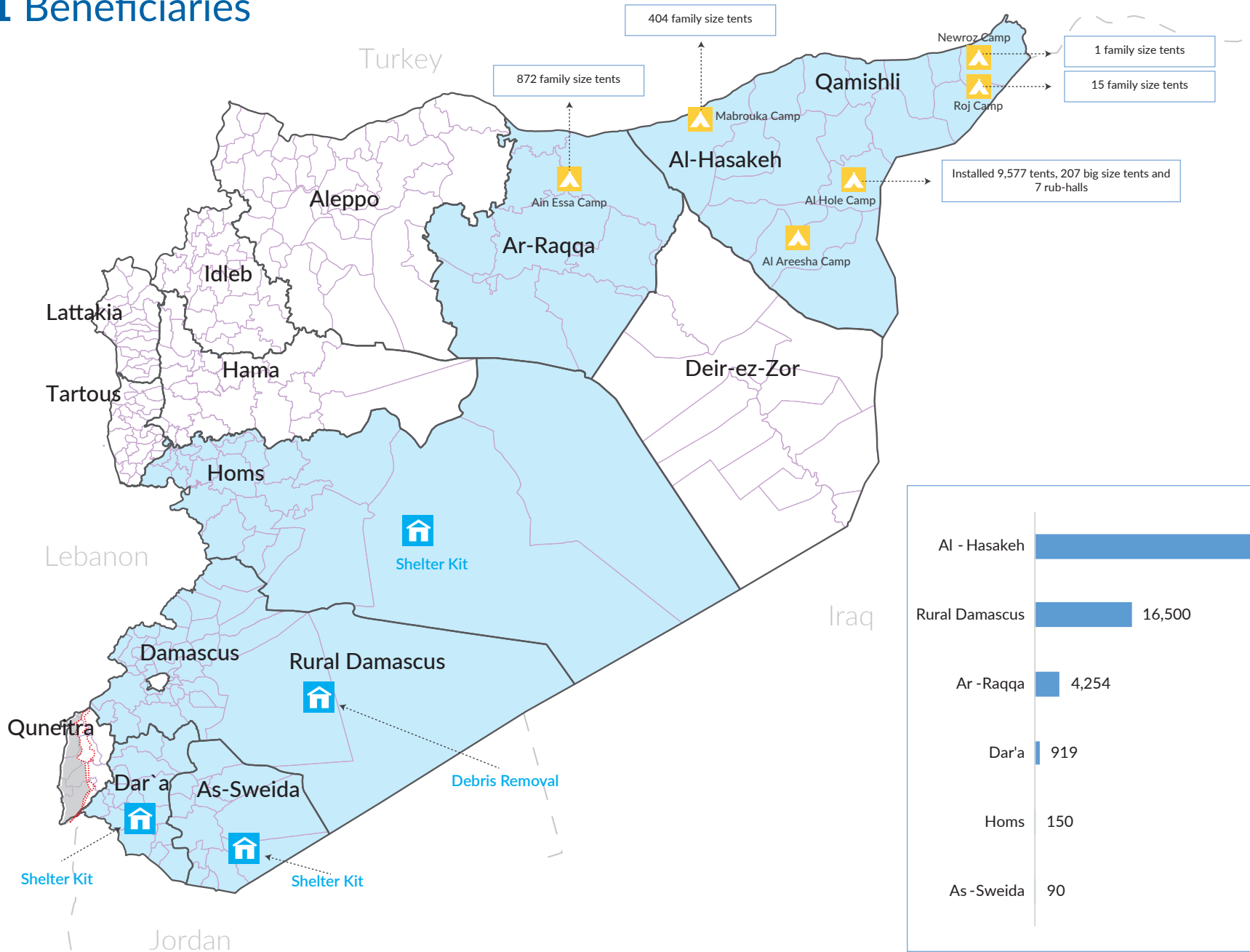
# UNHCR SYRIA CORE RELIEF ITEM DISTRIBUTION

**760,881** Beneficiaries (Received at least 1 CRI)



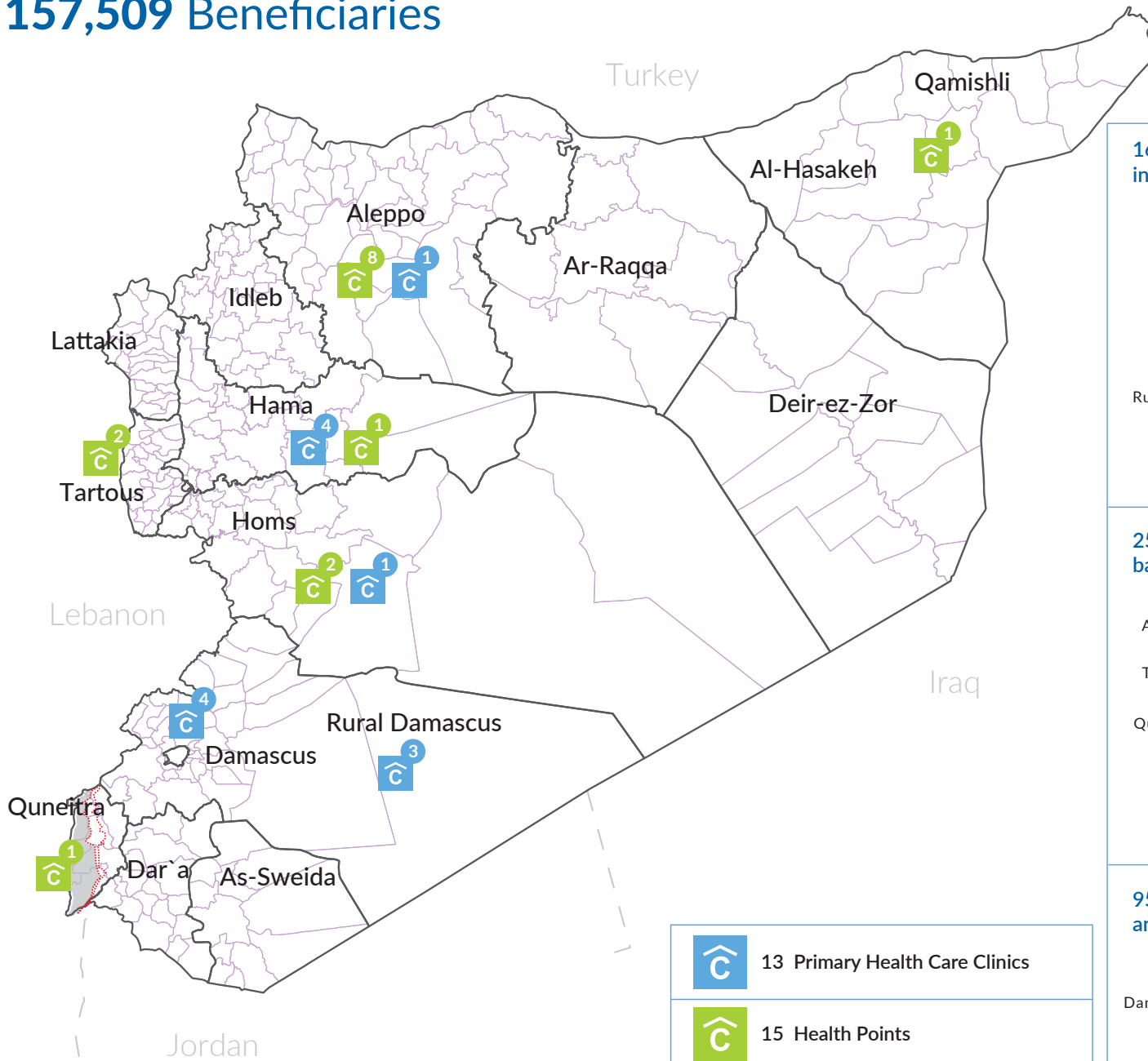

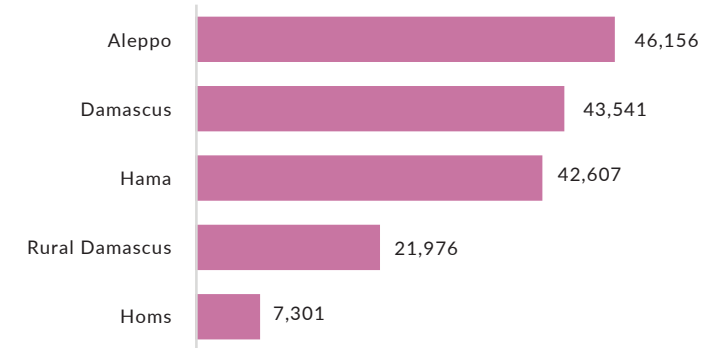

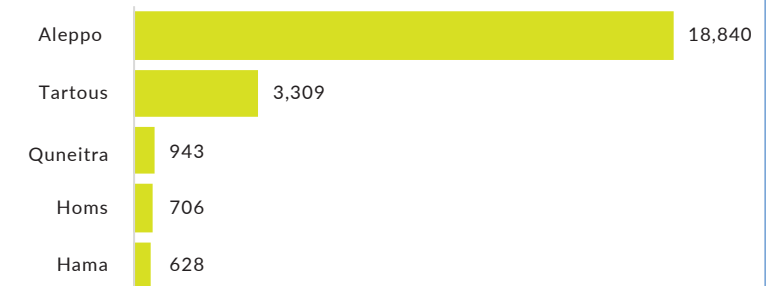
