

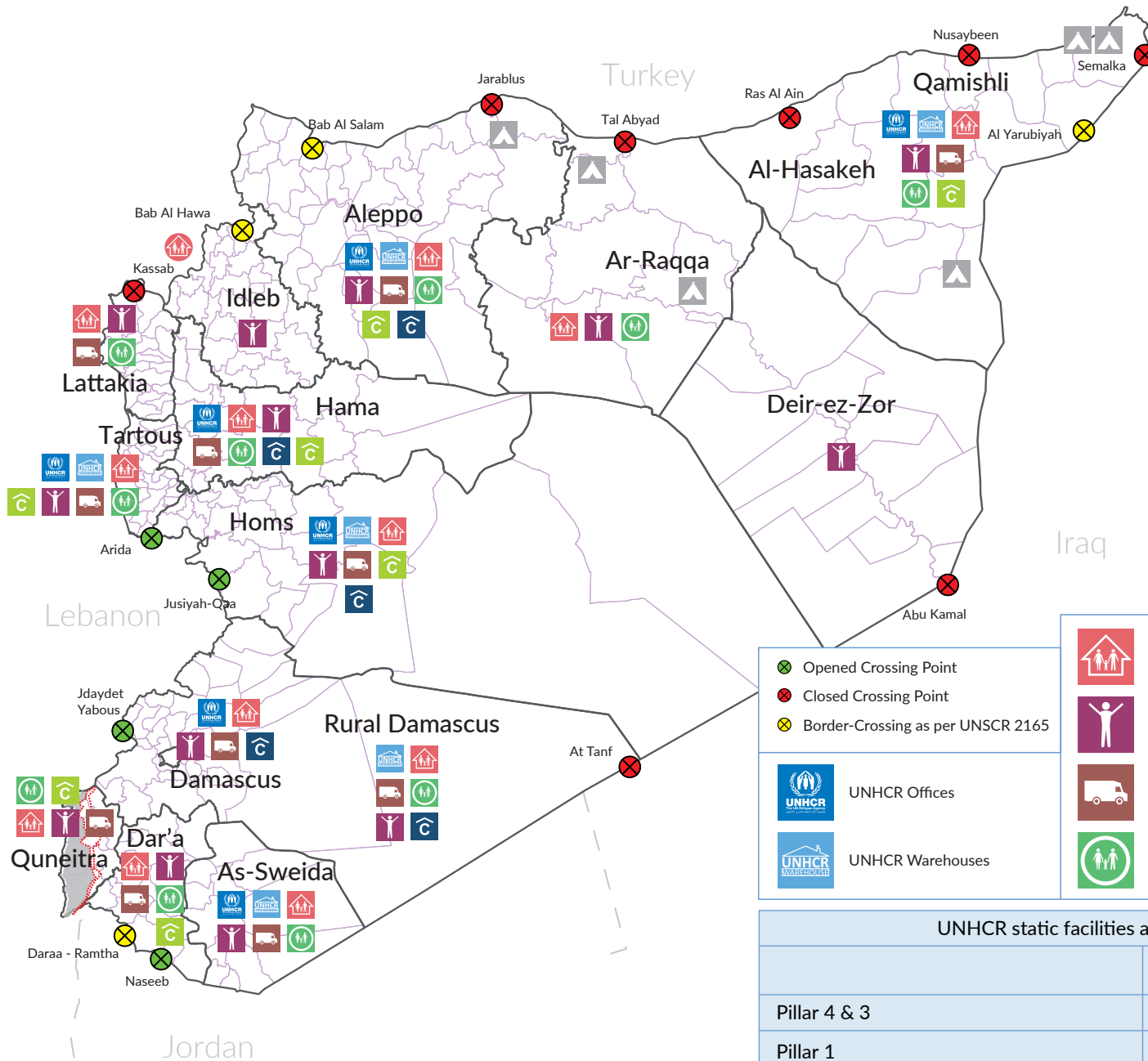


## UNHCR - Syria

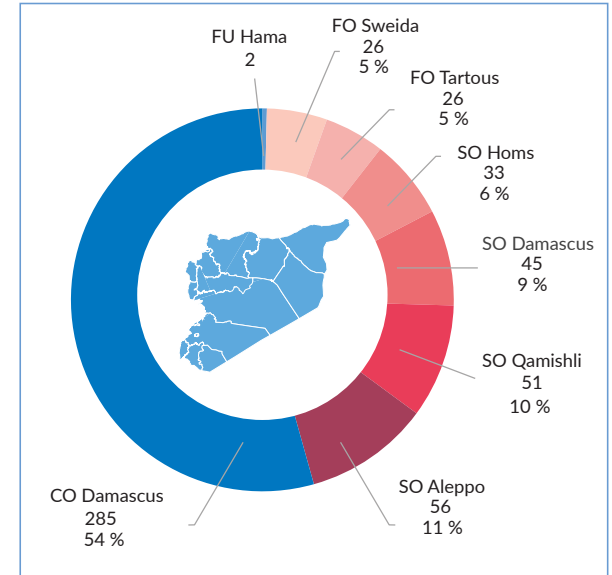
Main Activities

## 916,733 Persons Reached



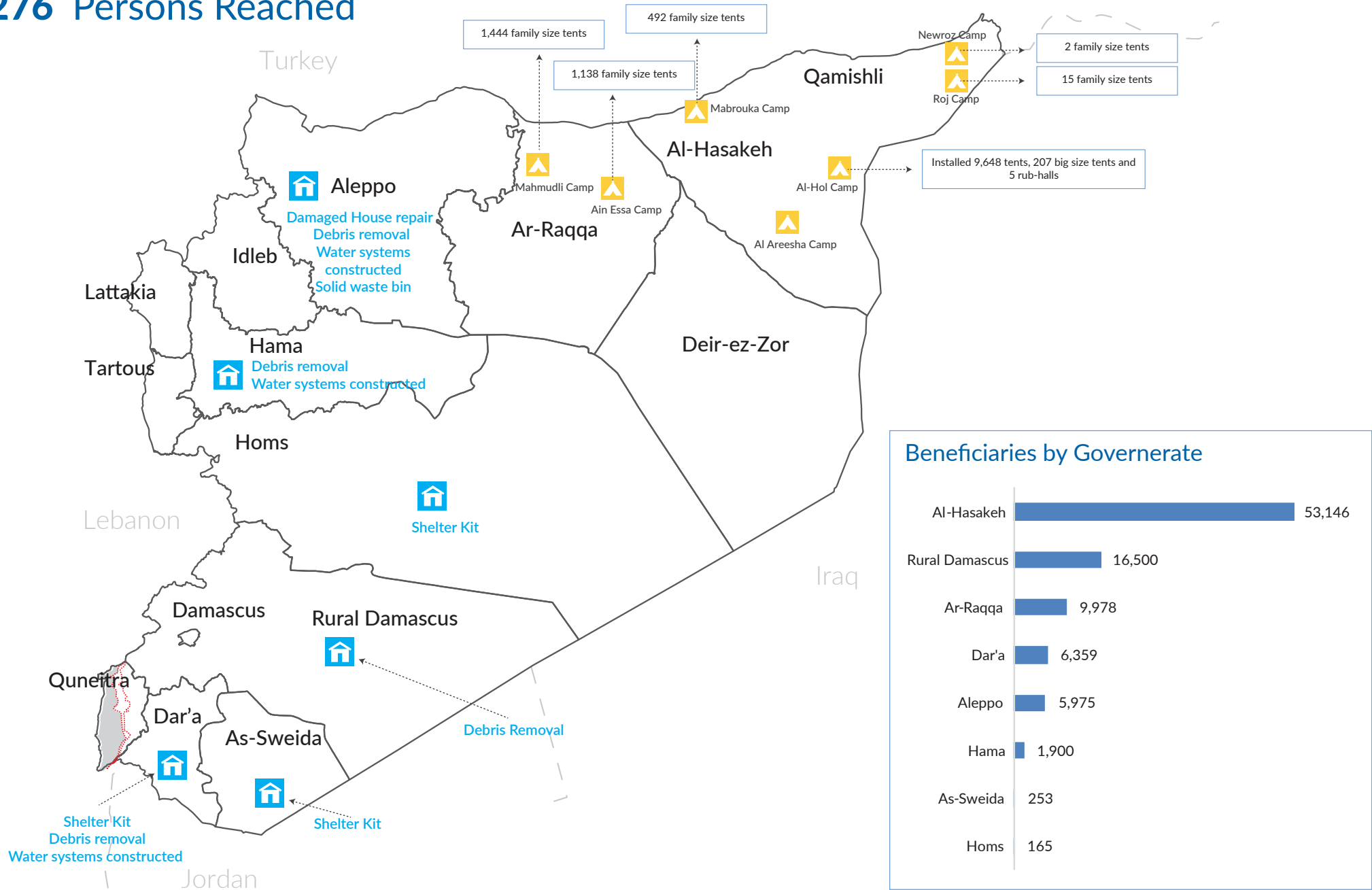
# UNHCR SYRIA CORE RELIEF ITEM (CRI) DISTRIBUTION

**1,016,094** Persons Reached (Received at least 1 CRI)



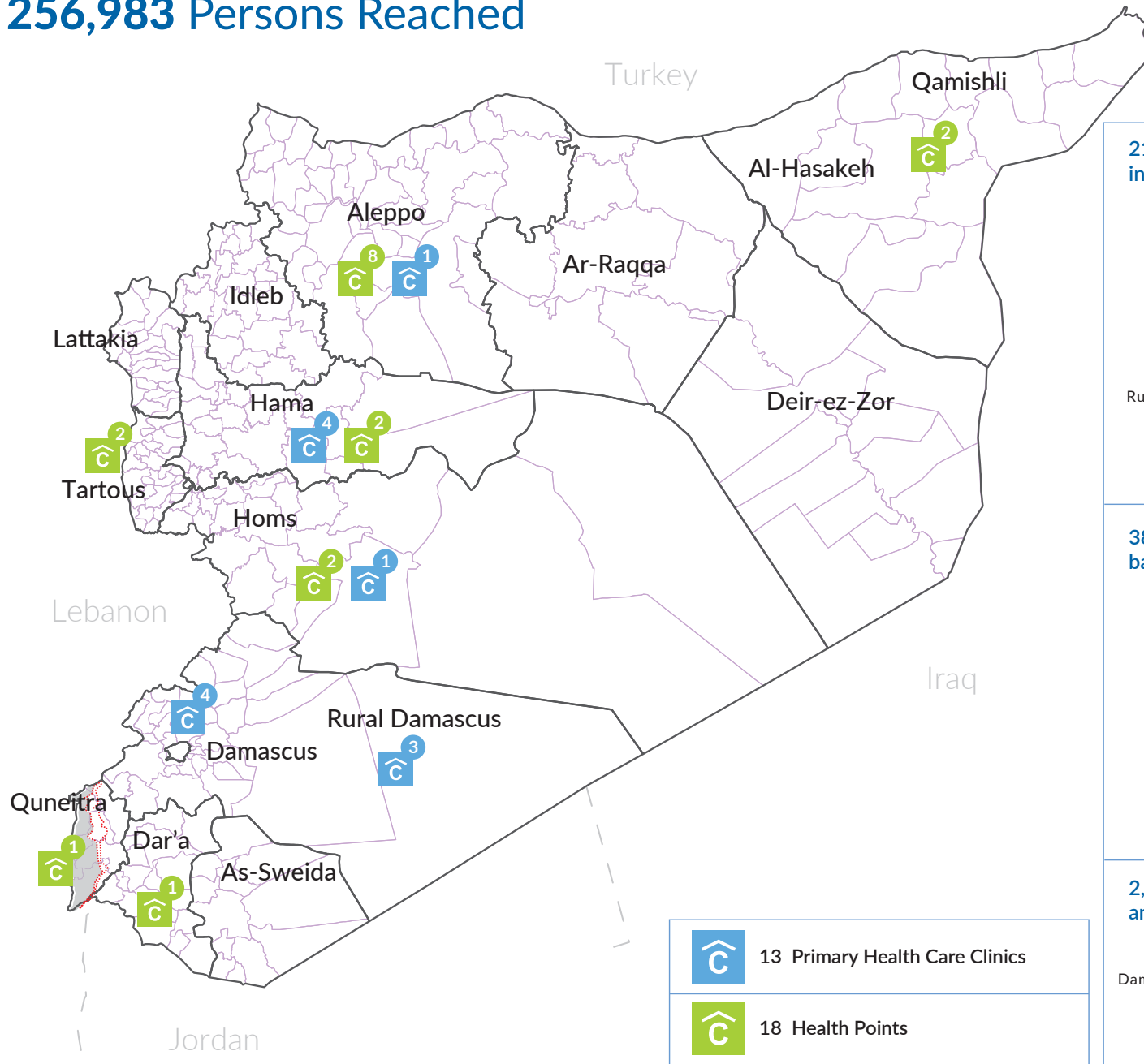

## 94,276 Persons Reached

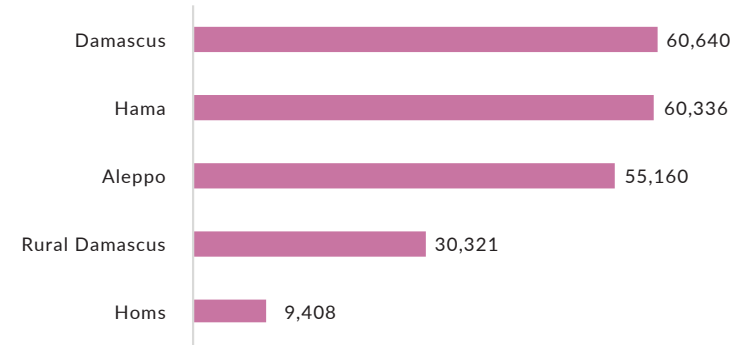

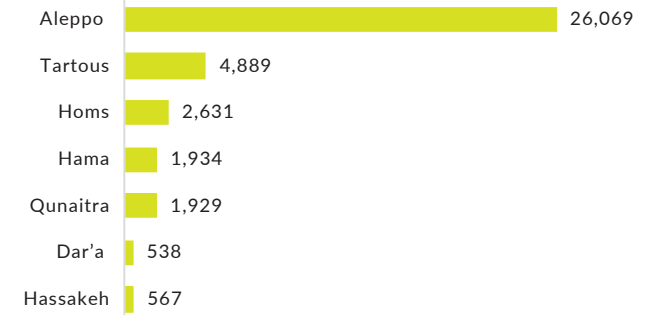

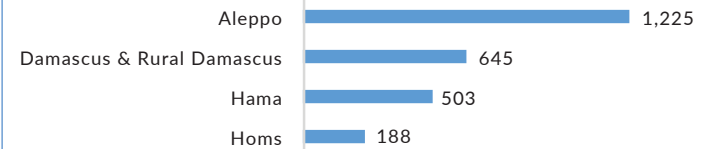

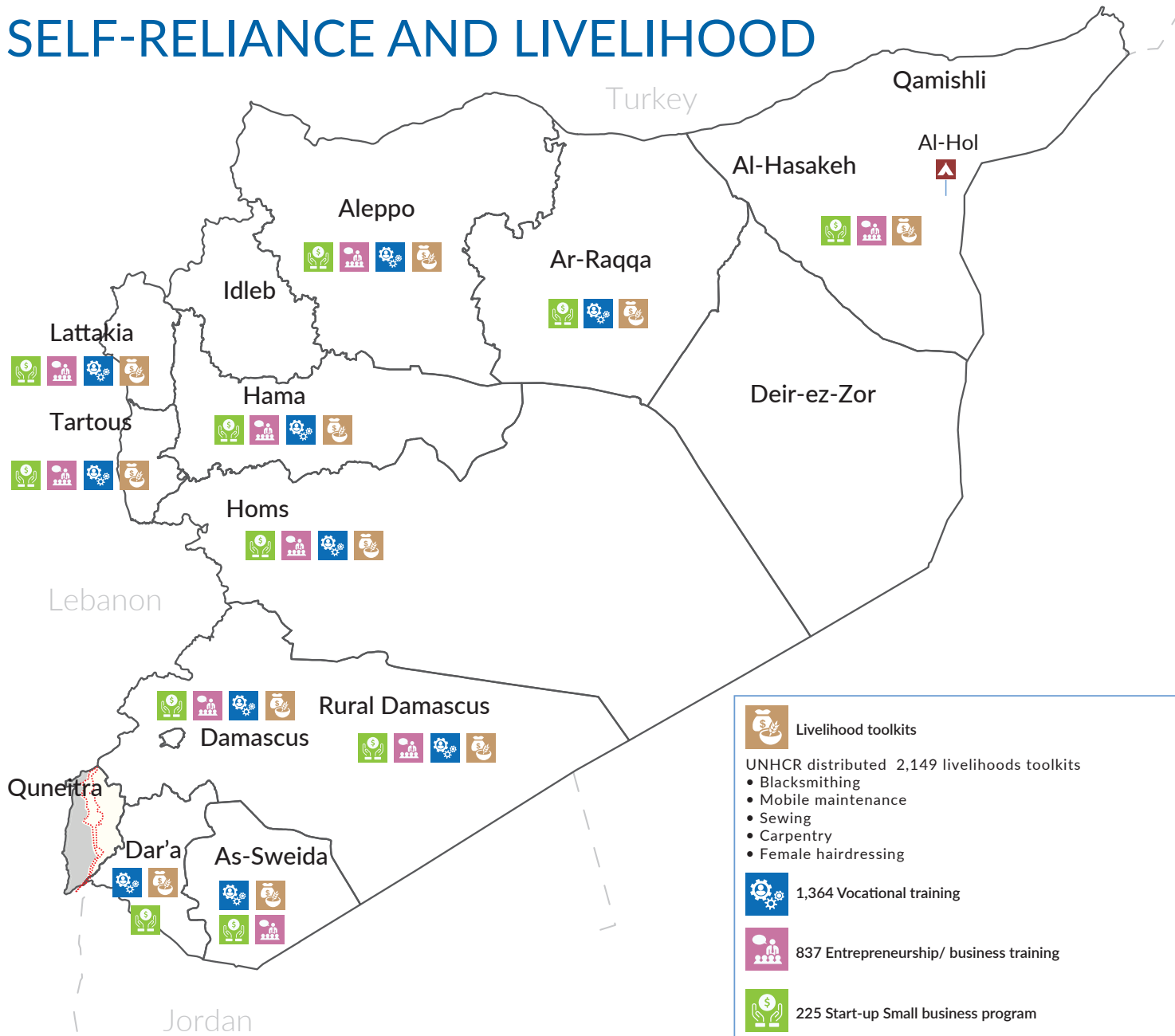
### 38,557 person of concerns reached by community based health activities

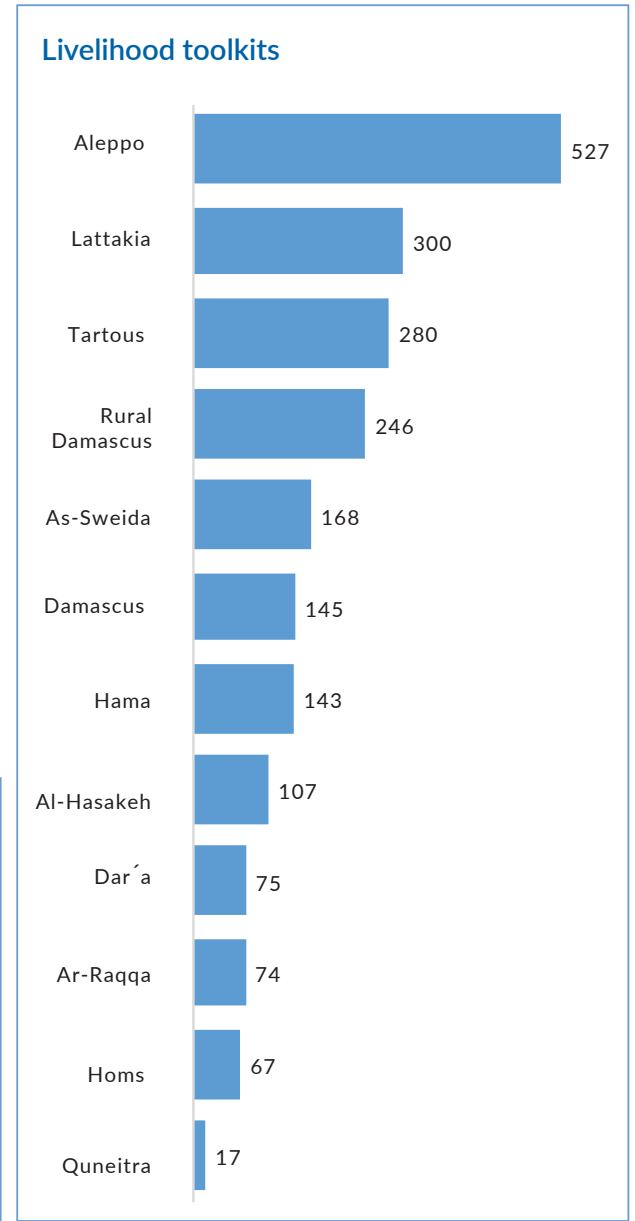

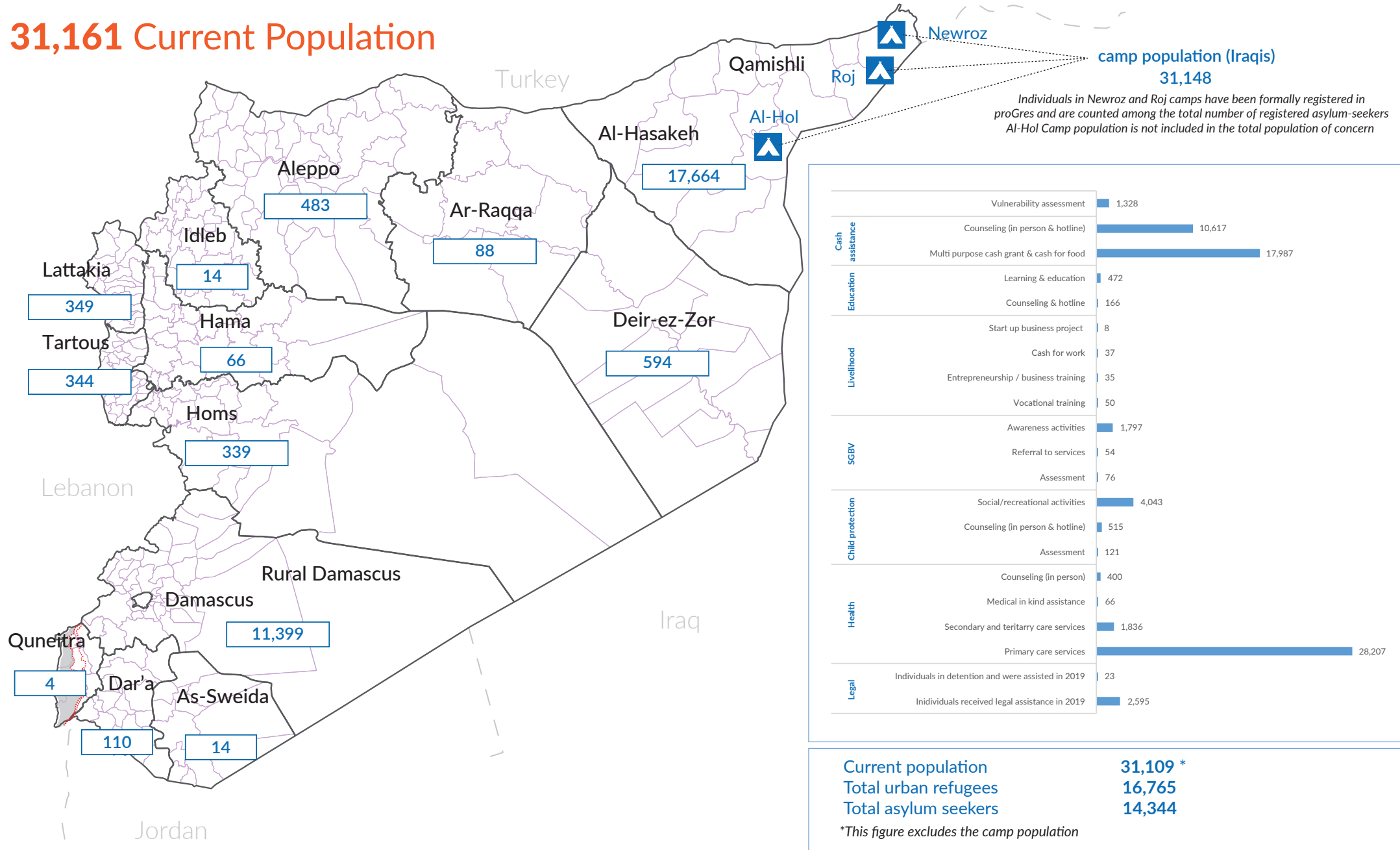

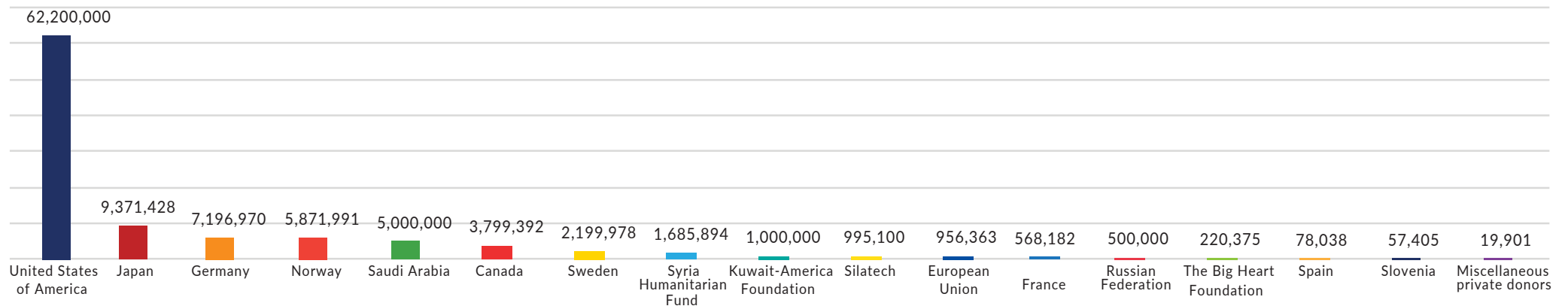
