



During the month of June 2021, the Registration Unit continued to scale up its effort in renewing expired UNHCR documents through remote modality. Remote registration renewal processes were conducted for 52,768 Persons of Concern (PoCs). In addition, the Registration Unit distributed Asylum Seeker/Refugee Certificates to 33,544 individuals/8,425 families.

To further speed up the renewal of expired documents, UNHCR has introduced in-person rapid renewal procedures at its Amman Registration Centre (Khalda) since mid-June. Social medial coverage and public information campaign on the new procedures was launched. Irbid and Mafraq offices have also introduced the same procedures in late June. The face-to-face method has proven to be highly effective, which helped increasing the number of renewed cases.

UNHCR collaborated closely with WFP in response to WFP's re-targeting exercise, resulting in the reduction in assistance for a number of refugees. Joint UNHCR-WFP communication forum with refugee volunteers were held in Irbid, Amman (Nuzha) and Aqaba. Registration Unit further supported WFP's appeal process by prioritizing the renewal of documents for refugees who are in the WFP appeal process.
