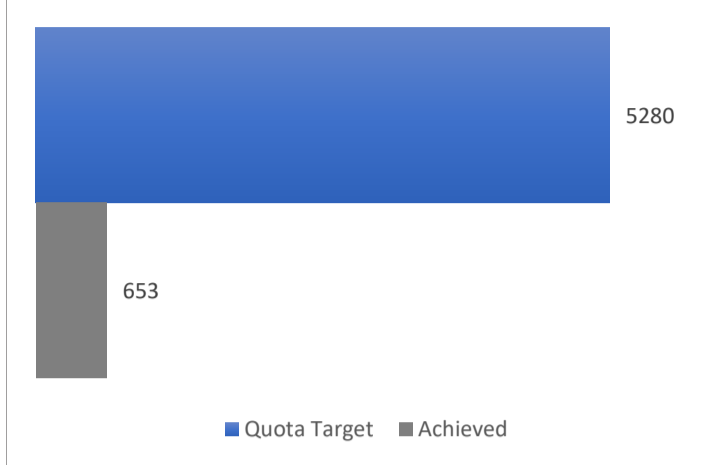

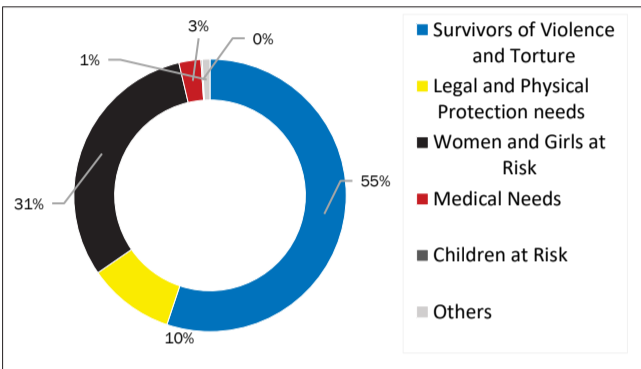

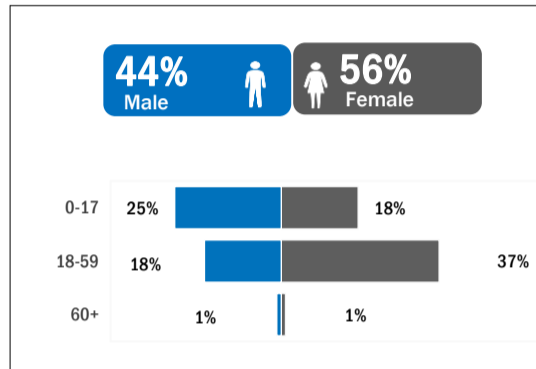
Overview

This dashboard provides a statistical snapshot of all UNHCR Rwanda's resettlement & complementary pathways activities up to the end of April 2021. Congolese refugees are prioritised for resettlement under an Enhanced Durable Solutions Strategy for the most protracted that has been implemented since 2012. As of 30 April 2021, 28,123 Congolese refugees have been submitted and 15,024 have departed on resettlement, mostly to the USA under a multi-year group process. Resettlement is also a key intervention for refugees evacuated from Libya under the Rwanda Emergency Transit Mechanism (ETM) established in September 2019. Since 2019, 515 persons of concern have been evacuated from Libya to the Rwanda ETM, of whom 260 have departed on resettlement. Since 2010, 520 refugees have been supported to access complementary pathways (mainly family reunification, education and employment).

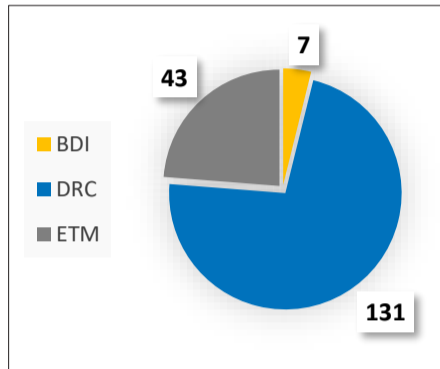

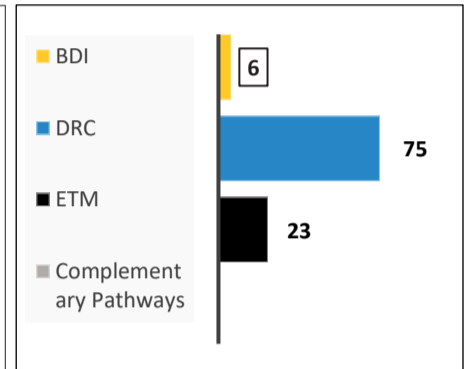
Demographics: By Age and Gender



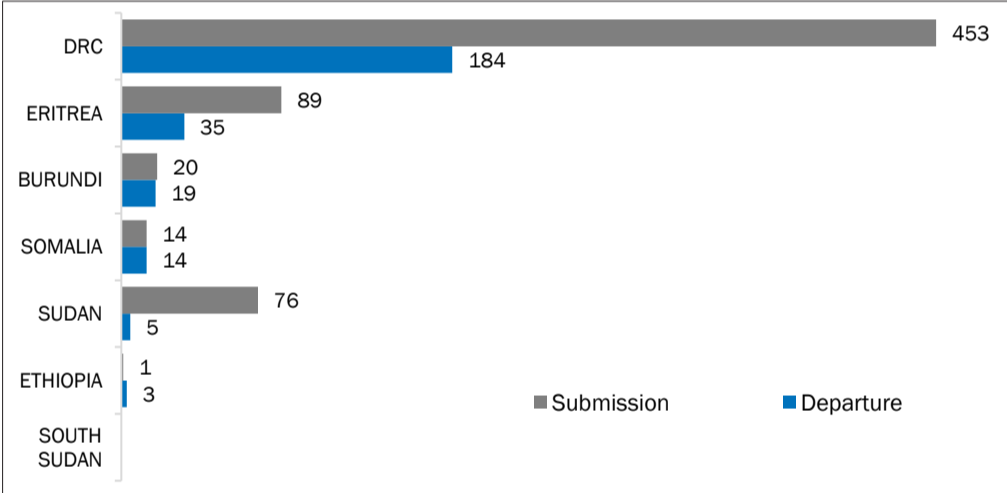
Submissions in April: 181 Individuals



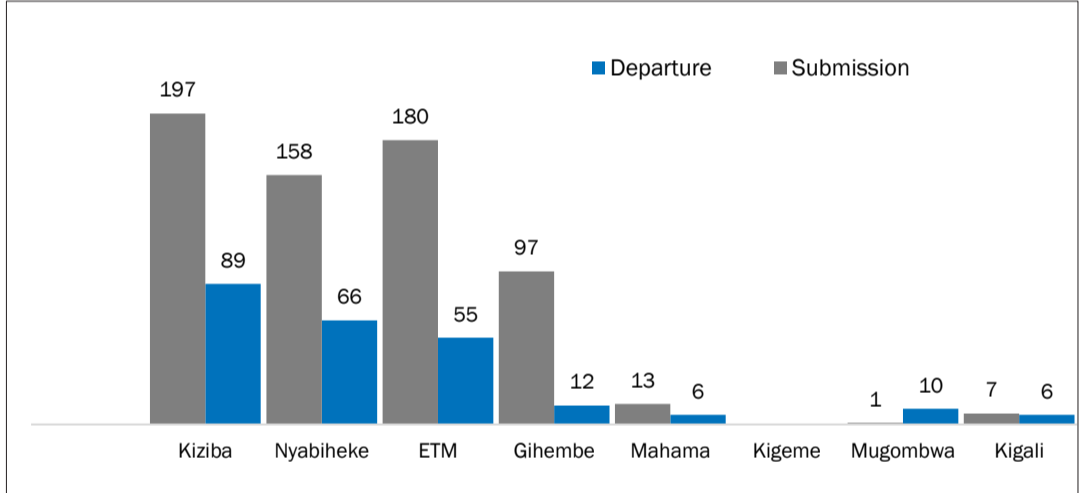
Departures in April: 104 Individuals



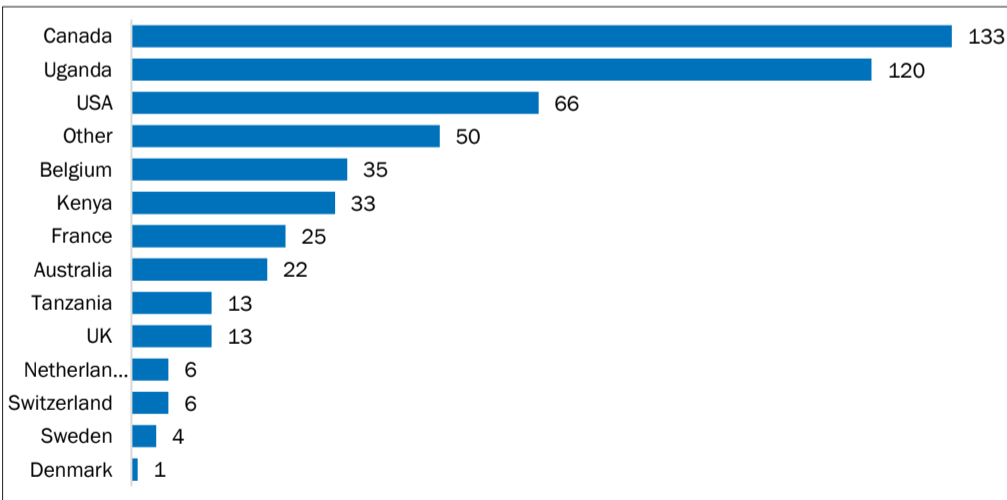
2021 Submissions & departures by Country of Origin



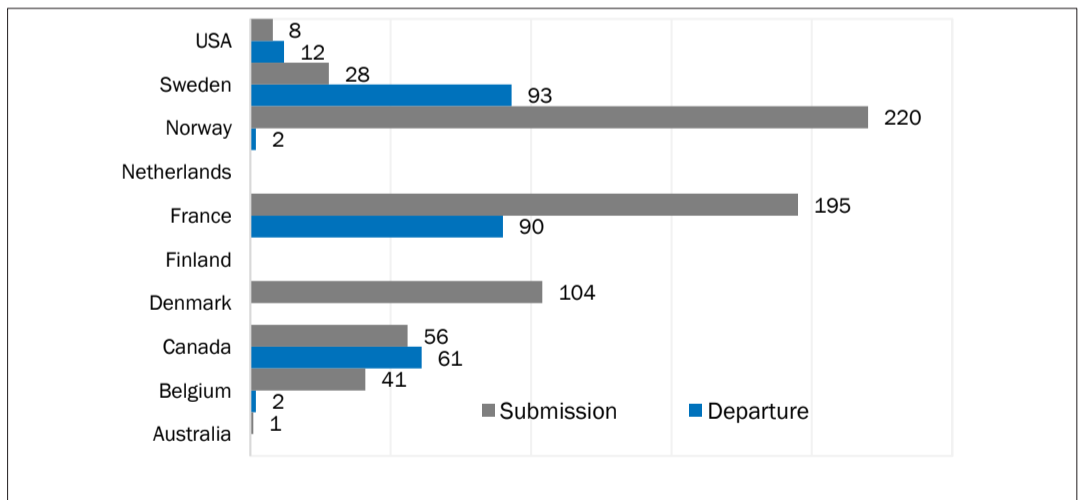
2021 Submissions & departures by location



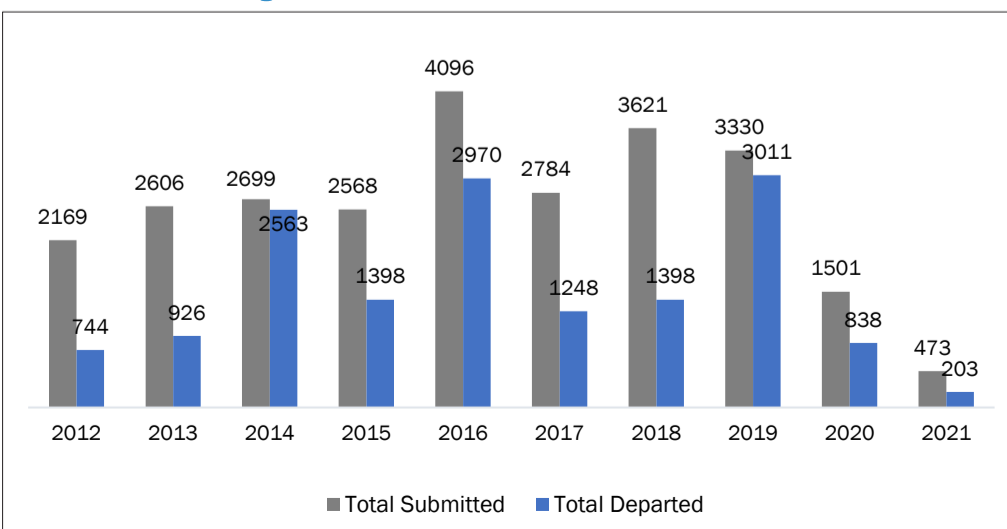
Complementary Pathways (2010-2021)
