

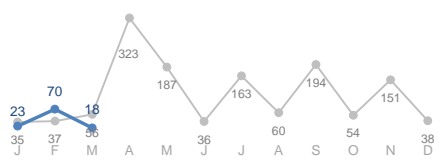

The UNHCR-led PRMN implemented in partnership with NRC reported 18,000 new internal displacements across the country in the month of March 2021. Of these, 12,000 were triggered by drought or lack of livelihoods while 6,000 were related to conflict/insecurity .

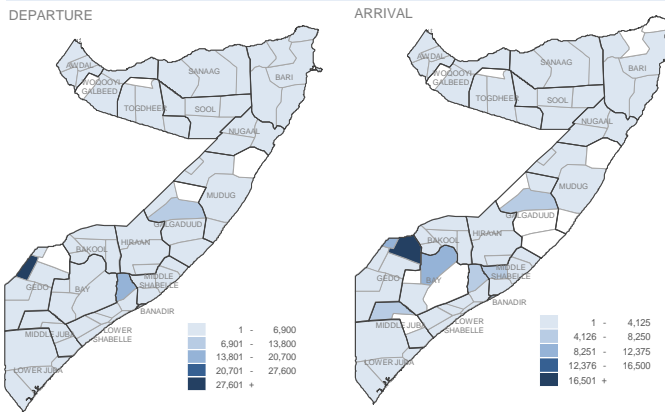

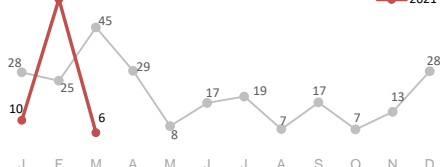


CONFLICT / INSECURITY DISPLACEMENTS

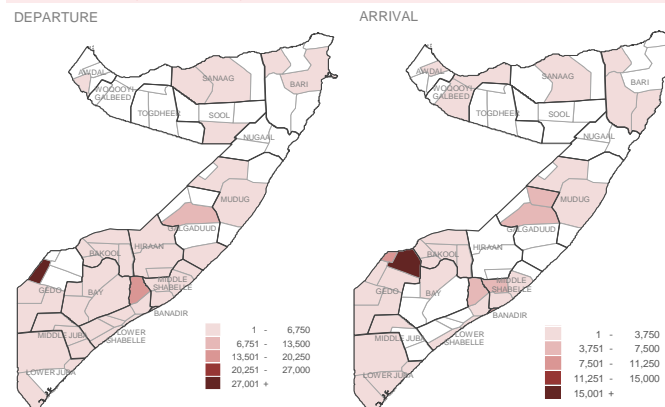

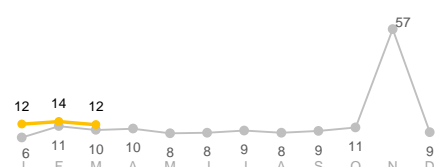


DROUGHT RELATED DISPLACEMENTS

During the month, just over 12,000 persons were displaced where the main reason given was drought. Baardheere (1,500) and Ceel Waaq (700) distrts in Gedo region, Qansax Dheere (1,000) district of Bay and Marka (700) district in Lower Shabelle region, recorded the highest displacements.

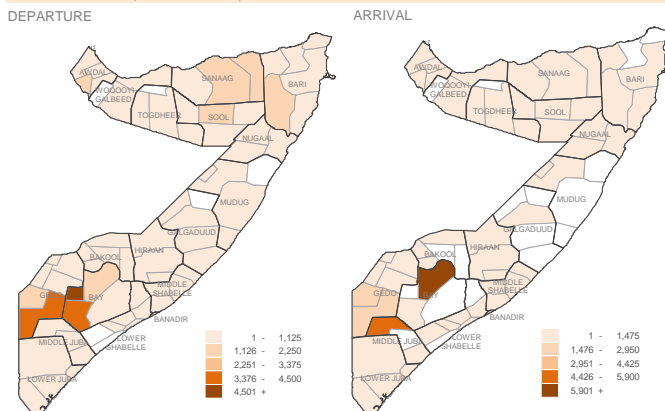

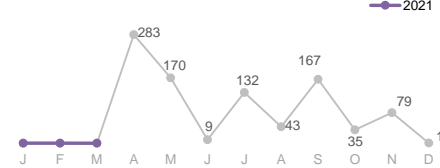

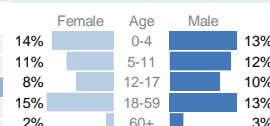

About PRMN

The PRMN (Protection & Return Monitoring Network) is a UNHCR-led project which identifies and reports on displacements (including returns) of populations in Somalia. The network also identifies and reports on protection risks and incidents underlying such movements. Only figures collected by PRMN are reported above. Not all displacements in Somalia are captured. This dashboard should be read in conjunction with the Notes on PRMN Methodology (<https://data2.unhcr.org/en/documents/details/53888>) which outline the approach and certain limitations. The figures shown are for numbers of individuals and are based on interviews with key informants and/or displaced households at destination (unless otherwise noted).
