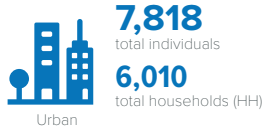
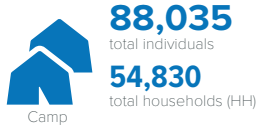
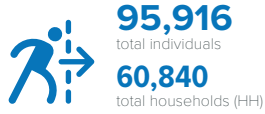
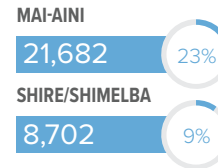
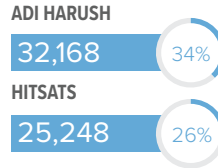


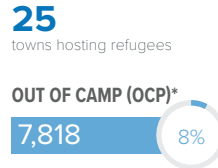
ERITREAN REFUGEE POPULATION IN TIGRAY



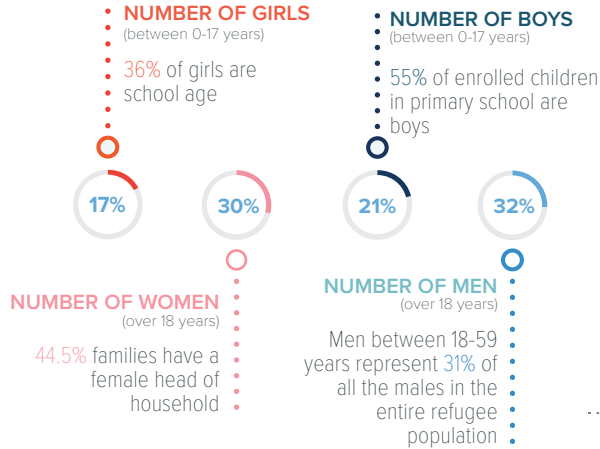

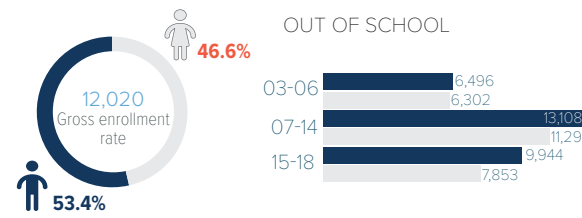

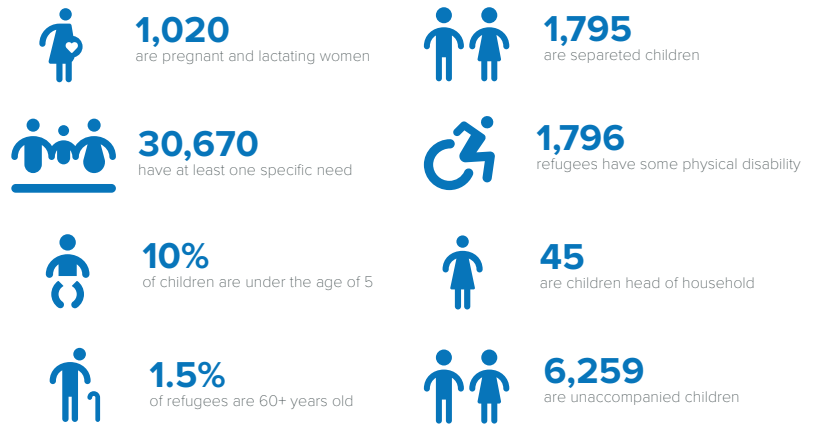

7,000 Eritrean refugees who were granted Addis OCP* status but are still registered under Shire (due to the COVID-19 related closure of UNHCR registration desks).

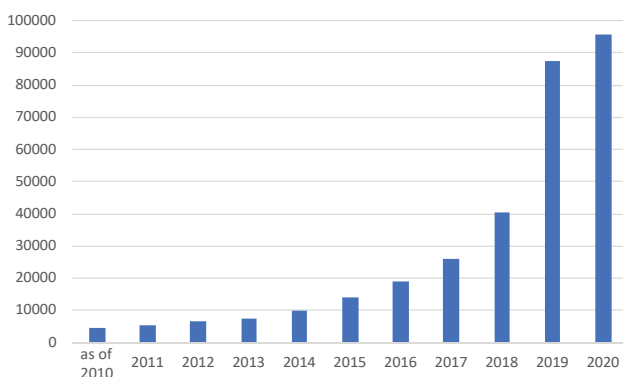
4/5,000 Eritrean refugees who came to Addis before the conflict with temporary permits e.g. to visit relatives. This number is an estimate according to Eritrean community leaders. Similarly to the previous 7,000 these refugees are registered under Shire.

* OCP - Out of Camp Policy - under this policy refugees are granted, by the Government of Ethiopia, to reside out of designated camps and freedom of movement.
