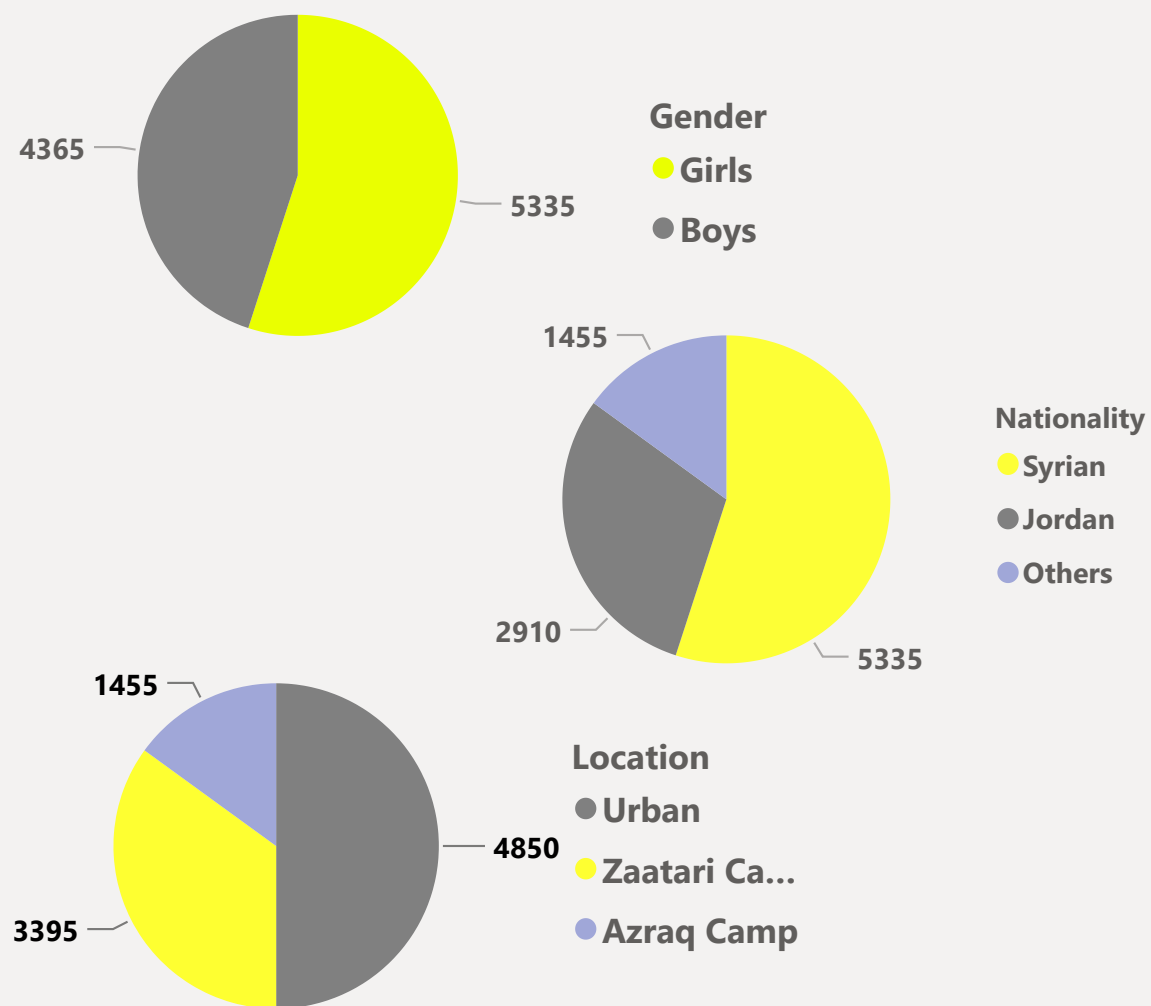


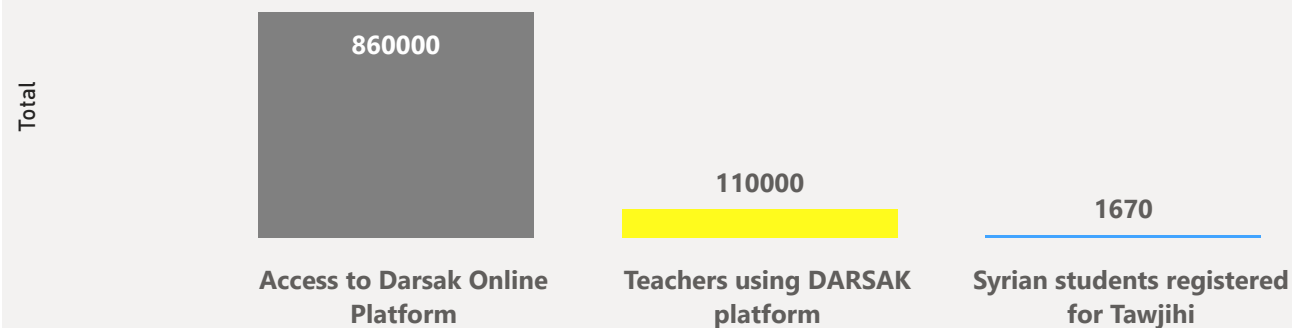

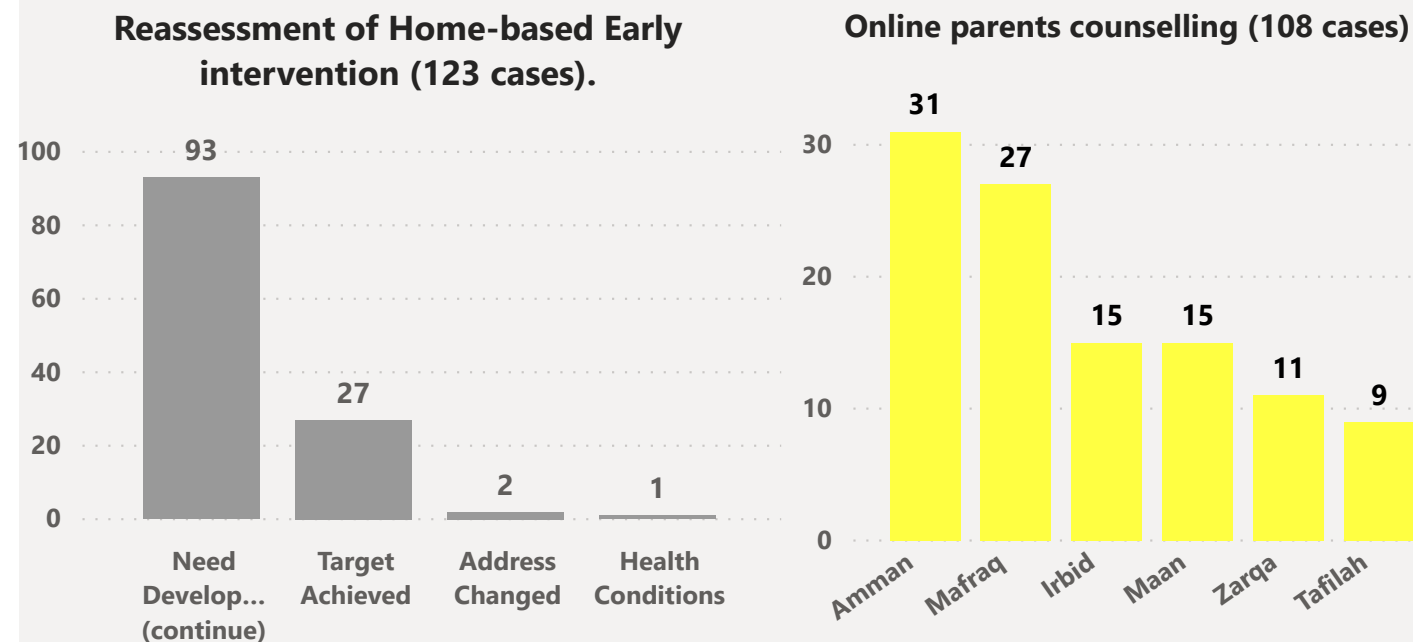

Training resumed at VTC centers. Working hours divided over 2 periods for groups exceed 50% capacity.


